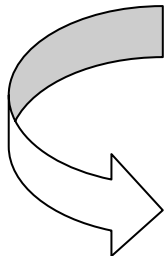
### Fundraising

**I. Saturday night BINGO:** Our volunteer shifts are on Saturday afternoon/evening two Saturday's each month throughout the school year. This fundraiser has been a great source of income for our students program. We need help with set-up, clean-up, card and ticket sales, food service, and other assorted jobs. The work is easy and there is a trained supervisor on hand at all times to train and guide you. We ask that all parents work 4-hour shifts, 4 times during the school year. Absolutely no experience is needed and the shifts go by quickly. Working BINGO makes more money for our program than any other kind of fundraiser – *and the money does not come out of parents' pockets!!*

**II. Irvine Invitational Field Tournament:** Held in October or November each Fall. A huge variety of volunteer jobs are yours for the picking at the annual Irvine Invitational Field Tournament (IIFT), another major fundraiser. On-the-job training is provided. Jobs include, just to name a few: set-up, teardown, concessions, crowd control, ticket/program sales, etc. Join the fun! *While the tournament features marching bands, funds earned benefit all of our music program groups.*
