Rules and Expectations for San Francisco

- 1) Bring at least \$60 for 8 meals and extra spending money. Taco Bell, McDonald's, and a Safeway (grocery store) are down the street from the hotel. Please keep your room clean—don't leave food lying around.
- 2) Do not leave your money or personal belongings unsupervised at any time.
- 3) Be prepared for bad weather with a raincoat, umbrella, and parka.
- 4) Only personal audio players are permitted. No extra speakers allowed.
- 5) Be courteous to all chaperons, staff, bus drivers, hotel personnel, and anyone in a position of authority. Do not hesitate to ask hotel staff for directions or bus info.—they are very helpful.
- 6) **NO DRUGS, NO SMOKING, NO ALCOHOL!** Use of any of these substances will result in your being sent home at your parent's expense and possible suspension from school and/or the program.
- 7) **No excessive noise in the rooms or hallways.** Only IHS tour members allowed in your room. If someone of the opposite sex is in your room before lights out, the door must remain propped open. Please note that this will increase the noise level in the hallway.
- 8) You must sleep in the room that you signed up for and ride in the bus you signed up for. **There will be no changes made!**
- 9) Food may be taken on the buses in small coolers. The buses **must remain clean** or this privilege will be taken away. Trash bags will be provided be sure to use them.
- 10) All curfews and rules must be observed or you may end up staying in a room with a chaperon or visa versa. You may lose any or all tour free time, and be required to perform duties back at school on your own time.
- 11) Room check is 10:00 PM each night. We must see the whites of your eyes, so please plan showers accordingly.
- 12) Remember to respect **all** of the guests in the hotel. Remember we are taking only 40 of 500 rooms. There will be a large number of visitors that are not interested in extra noise. *Be respectful!*
- 13) Chinatown is off-limits, unless accompanied by an adult chaperone!
- 14) Remember to represent IHS with pride. Let's earn the privilege of having this trip again.
